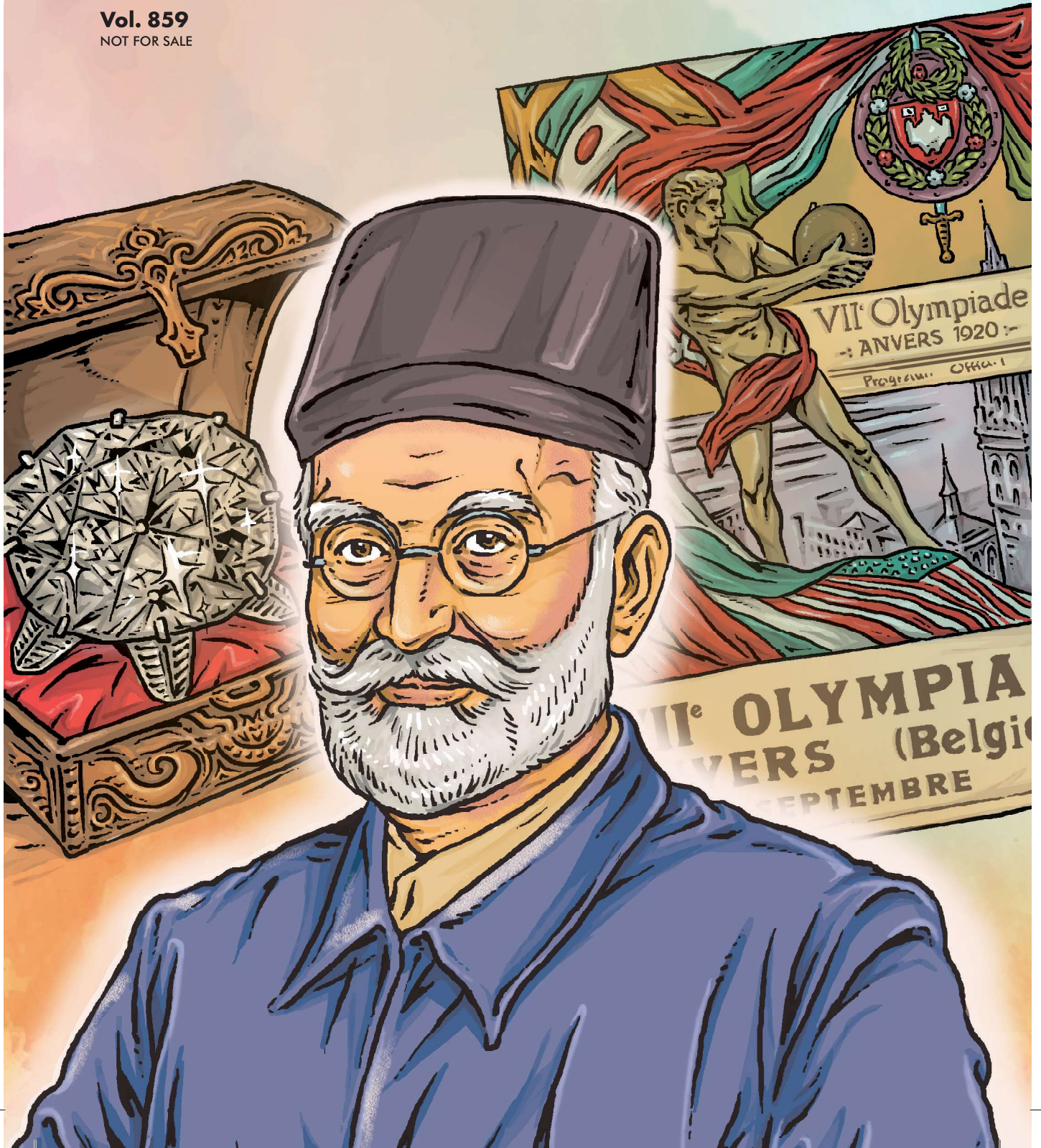

PIONEERS OF INDUSTRY IN INDIA, THE TATAS SURELY NEED NO INTRODUCTION. EVER SINCE THE FIRST TRADING COMPANY WAS FOUNDED BY JAMSETJI TATA IN 1868, THE TATAS HAVE ASPIRED TO ESTABLISH INDIA AS AN ECONOMICALLY AND INTELLECTUALLY SELF-RELIANT NATION.



JAMSETJI, 'THE MAN WHO SAW TOMORROW', WAS BLESSED WITH FAMILY WHO RESPECTED AND SHARED HIS VISION. HIS SONS, DORAB AND RATAN, AND COUSIN, R.D. DORAB WAS BORN TO JAMSETJI AND HEERABAI TATA ON 27 AUGUST, 1859.

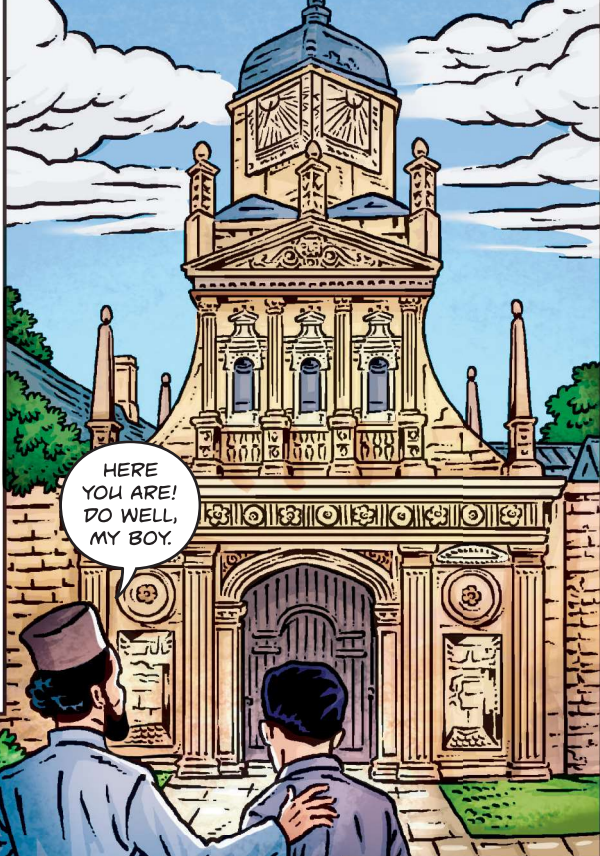

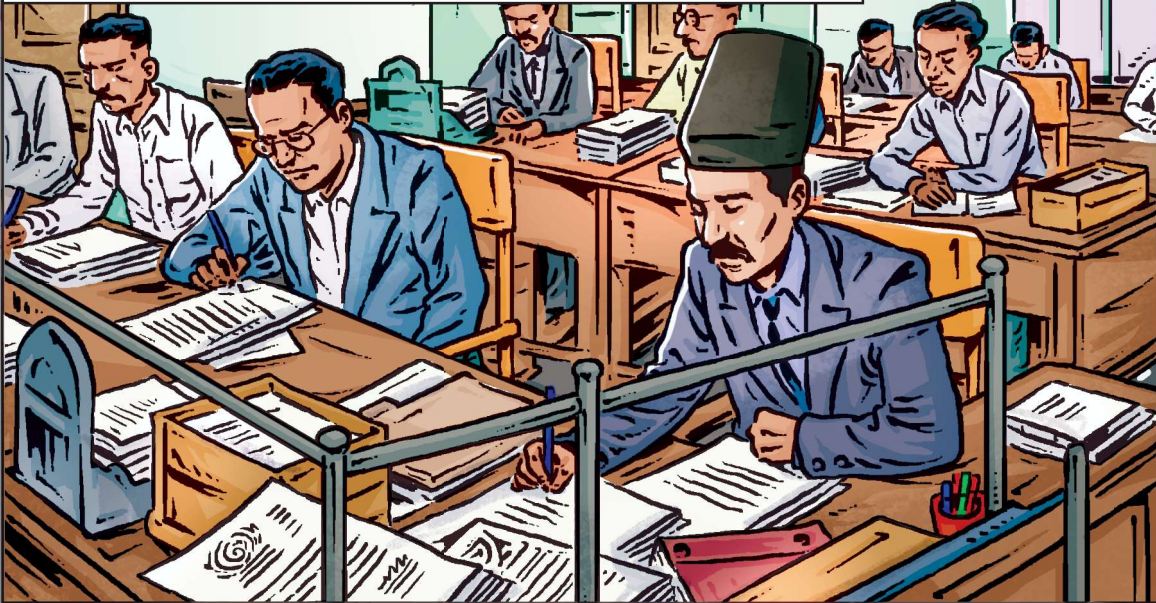

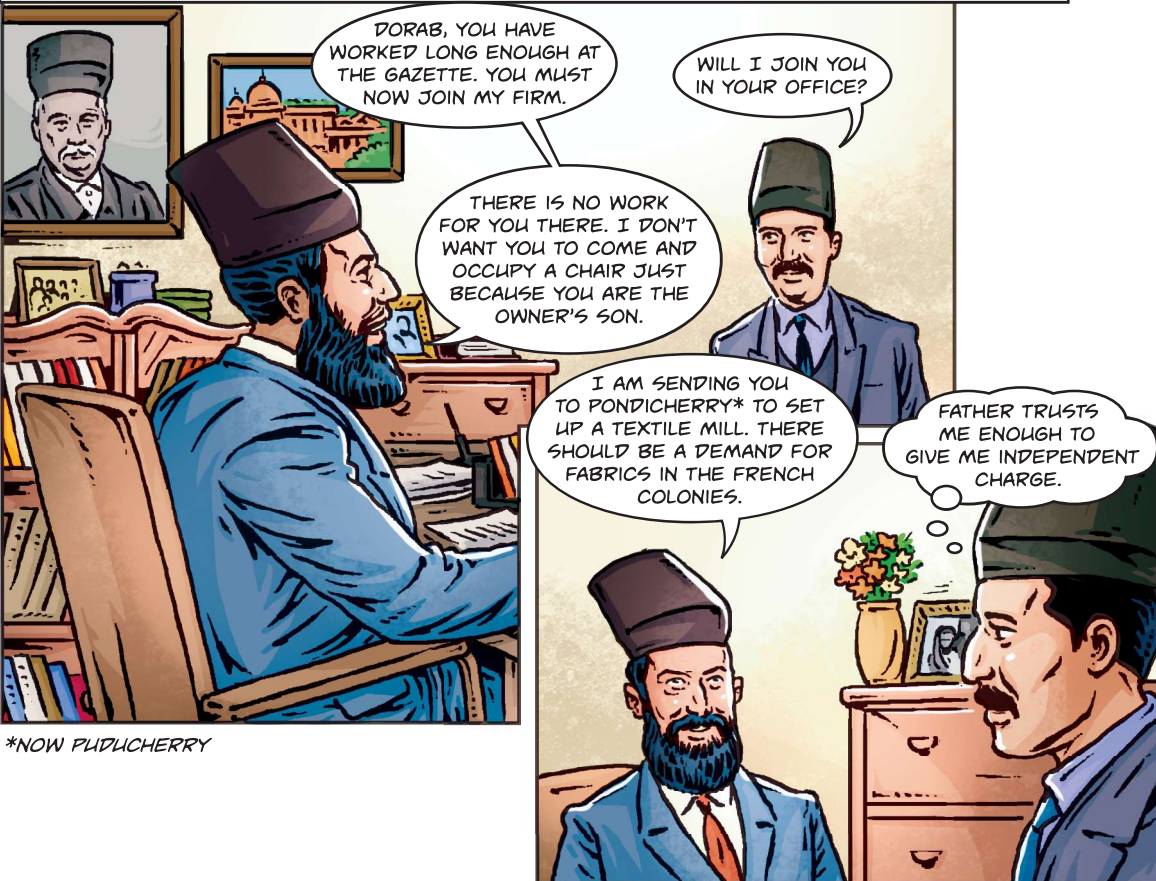

DORAB SPENT TWO YEARS IN CAMBRIDGE AND RETURNED TO INDIA IN 1879, ON HIS GRANDFATHER'S INSISTENCE. AFTER GRADUATING FROM ST XAVIER'S COLLEGE, BOMBAY, IN 1882, HE JOINED THE BOMBAY GAZETTE TO TRAIN AS A JOURNALIST.



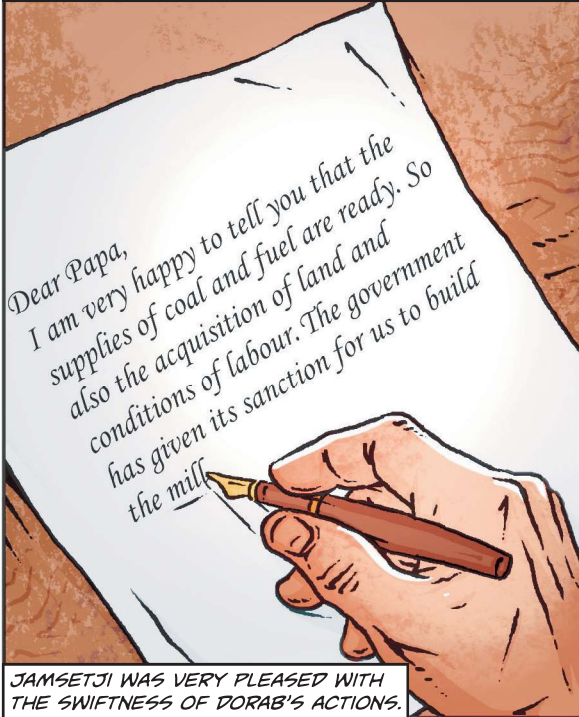

JAMSETJI WAS VERY PLEASED WITH THE SWIFTESS OF DORAB'S ACTIONS.

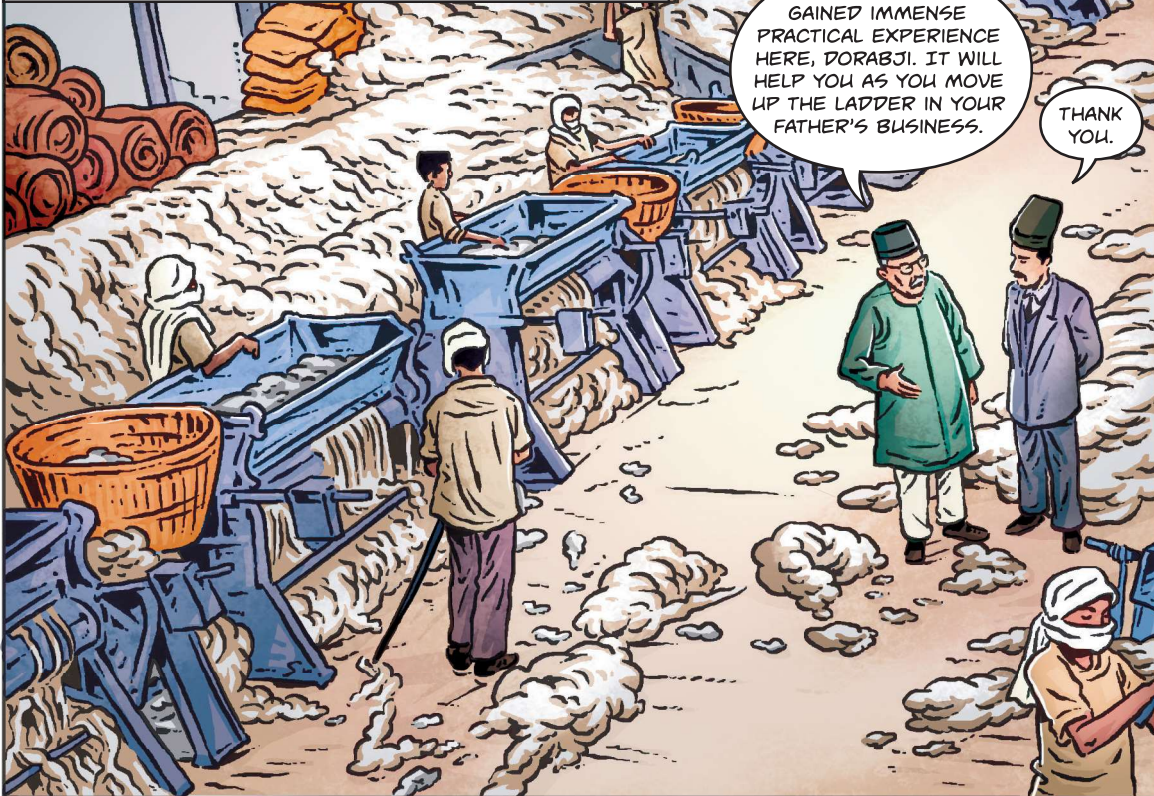

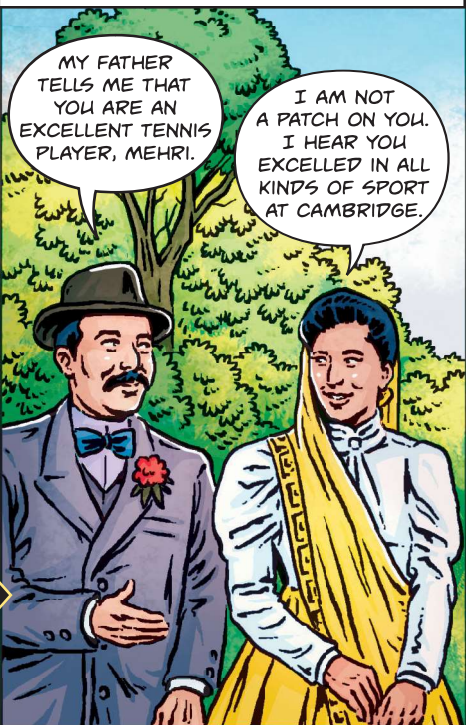
IT WAS A GOOD ARRANGEMENT. R.D.* WAS IN CHARGE OF INTERNATIONAL ASPECTS AND RATAN, WHO WAS STILL A YOUNG BOY, JOINED THE FIRM ONLY IN 1896, LEAVING DORAB TO WORK CLOSELY WITH HIS FATHER.

ONE OF JAMSETJI'S CHERISHED DREAMS WAS TO SET UP A WORLD-CLASS INSTITUTE OF HIGHER LEARNING IN INDIA. AFTER NEGOTIATIONS, HE WAS INVITED BY THE DIWAN OF MYSORE TO SET UP THE INSTITUTE. JAMSETJI FOUND MORE THAN FINANCIAL HELP ON ONE OF HIS TRIPS.

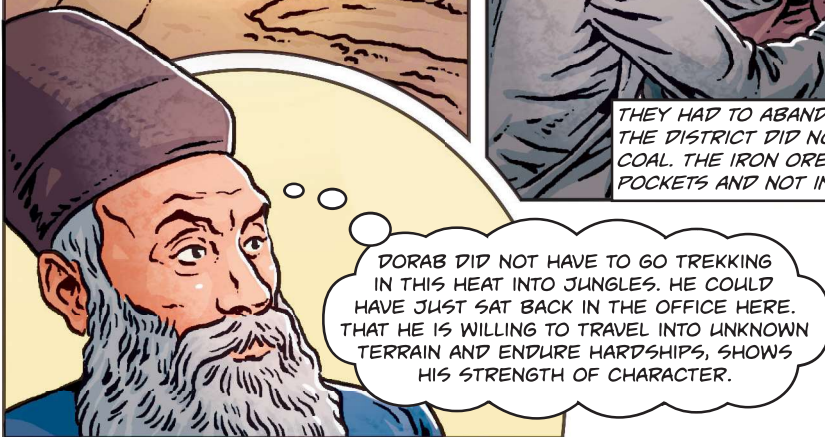
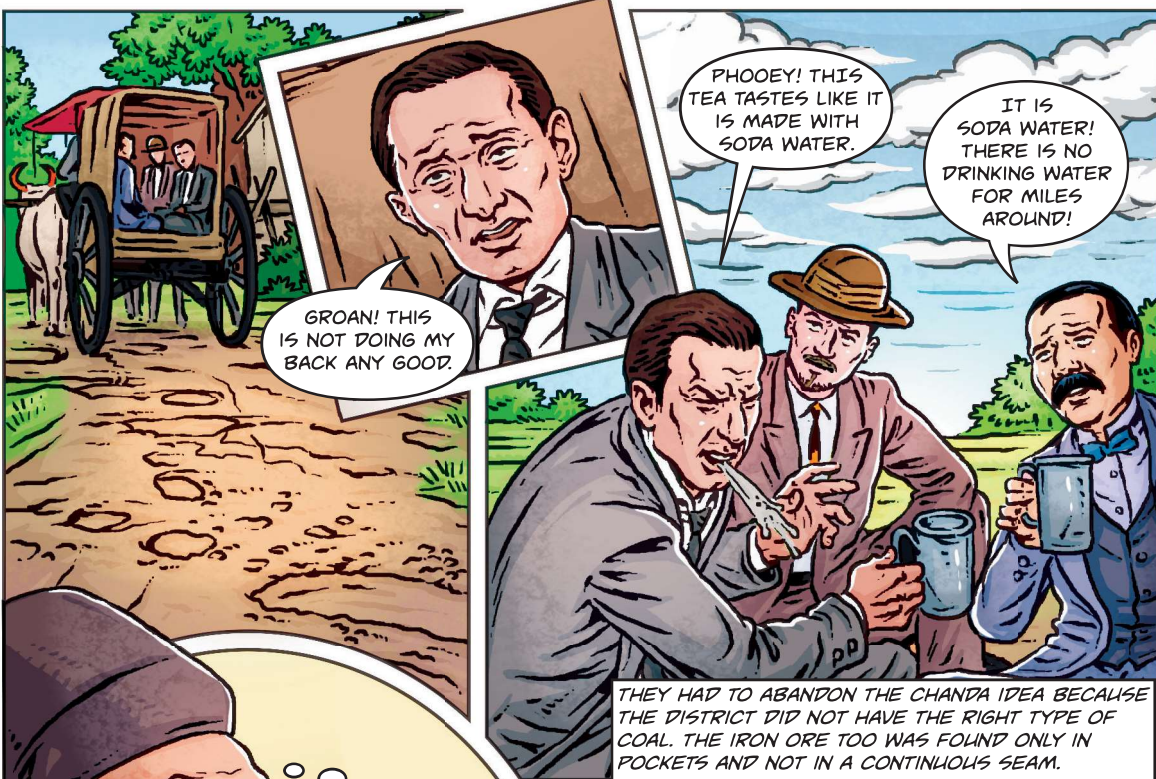
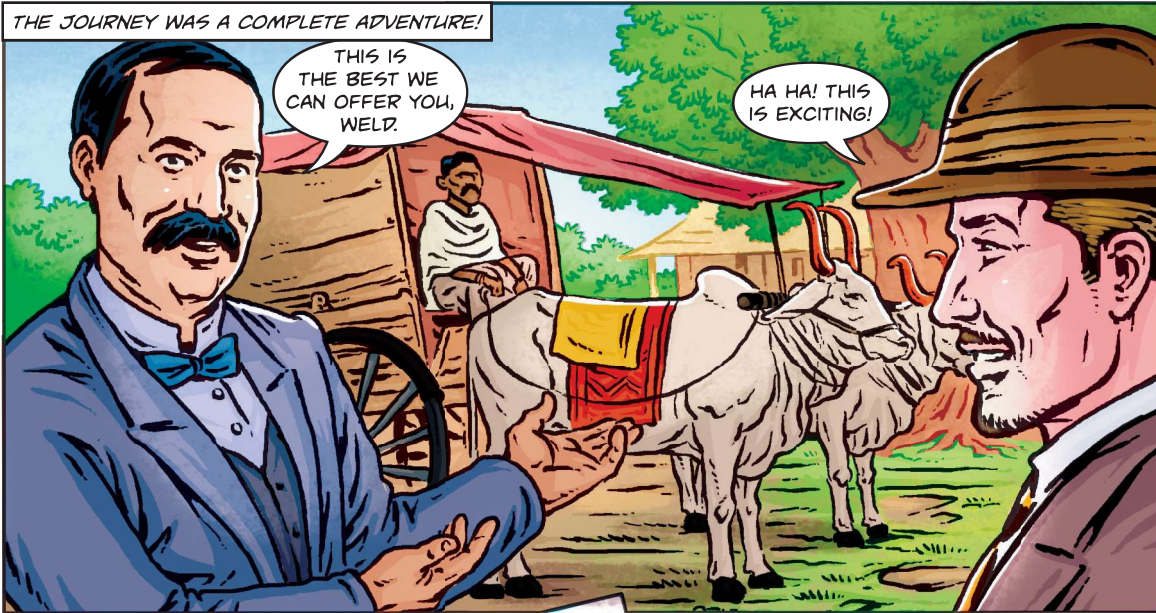
WHILE THE SENTIMENT OF SWARAJYA OR SELF-RULE WAS GRIPPING INDIA, JAMSETJI TATA HAD HIS OWN DREAMS TO MAKE INDIA SELF-RELIANT IN IRON AND STEEL AND TO PROVIDE CLEAN ELECTRIC POWER TO BOMBAY. IN 1899, WHEN MINING LAWS WERE LIBERALISED IN BRITISH INDIA



THE NECESSARY PAPERWORK WAS SOON IN PLACE BUT FINDING SUFFICIENT RAW MATERIAL (ORE) PROVED TO BE A DIFFICULT TASK. THOUGH RENOWNED GEOLOGISTS WERE BEING CONSULTED, DORAB WAS NOT ONE TO SIT BACK AND WAIT FOR RESULTS.



EMINENT GEOLOGIST, C.M. WELD, DORAB AND HIS COUSIN, SHAHPURJI SAKLATVALA, WERE ON THEIR WAY TO CHANDA IN CENTRAL INDIA, TO LOOK FOR COAL AND IRON ORE.



DORAB WAS COMPLETELY INVOLVED IN THE ORE FINDING PROCESS. ONE DAY, ON A VISIT WITH C.M. WELD, TO A MUSEUM IN NAGPUR:



UNFORTUNATELY, THERE WAS NO STEADY SUPPLY OF LIMESTONE, COKING COAL OR WATER IN DURG. ALL THREE ARE NEEDED IN THE PRODUCTION OF IRON AND STEEL.

EVERYTHING WAS STILL UNDERWAY WHEN JAMSETJI TATA PASSED AWAY IN 1904. IT FELL TO DORAB, THE NEW CHAIRMAN OF TATA AND SONS, TO TAKE CHARGE AND FULFILL HIS FATHER'S DREAMS. ONE CHILLY WINTER MORNING IN DECEMBER 1904:



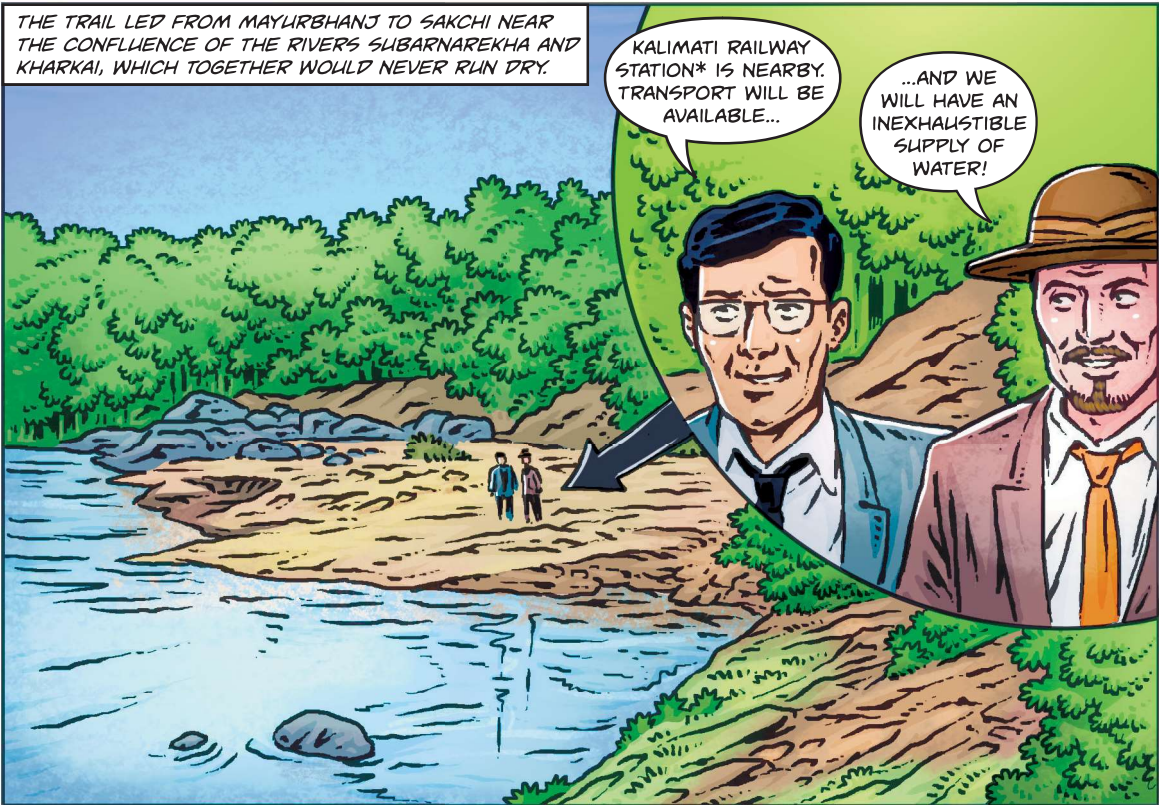

WITH THE LAND AND MONEY DONATED BY THE ROYAL FAMILY OF MYSORE, JAMSETJI'S PERSONAL WEALTH AND MUCH HARD WORK BY DORAB AND HIS TEAM, THE INDIAN INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE* WAS ESTABLISHED IN BANGALORE[^] IN 1909. THE FIRST BATCH OF STUDENTS WAS ADMITTED IN 1911.



HOMI BHABHA, CV RAMAN AND VIKRAM SARABHAI WERE AMONG THE MANY STALWARTS ASSOCIATED WITH IT.

DORAB'S SUCCESSES WERE RECOGNISED ON A GRAND LEVEL IN 1910 WHEN HE WAS KNIGHTED BY KING EDWARD VII.



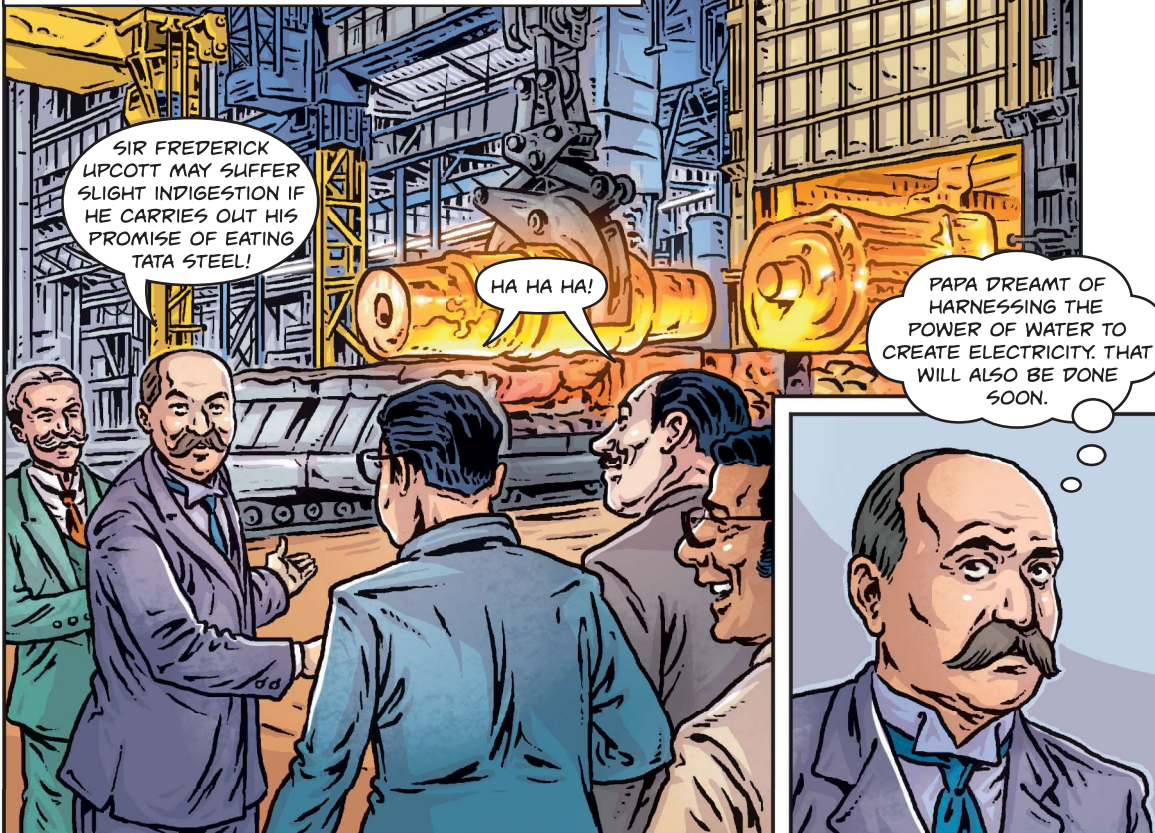

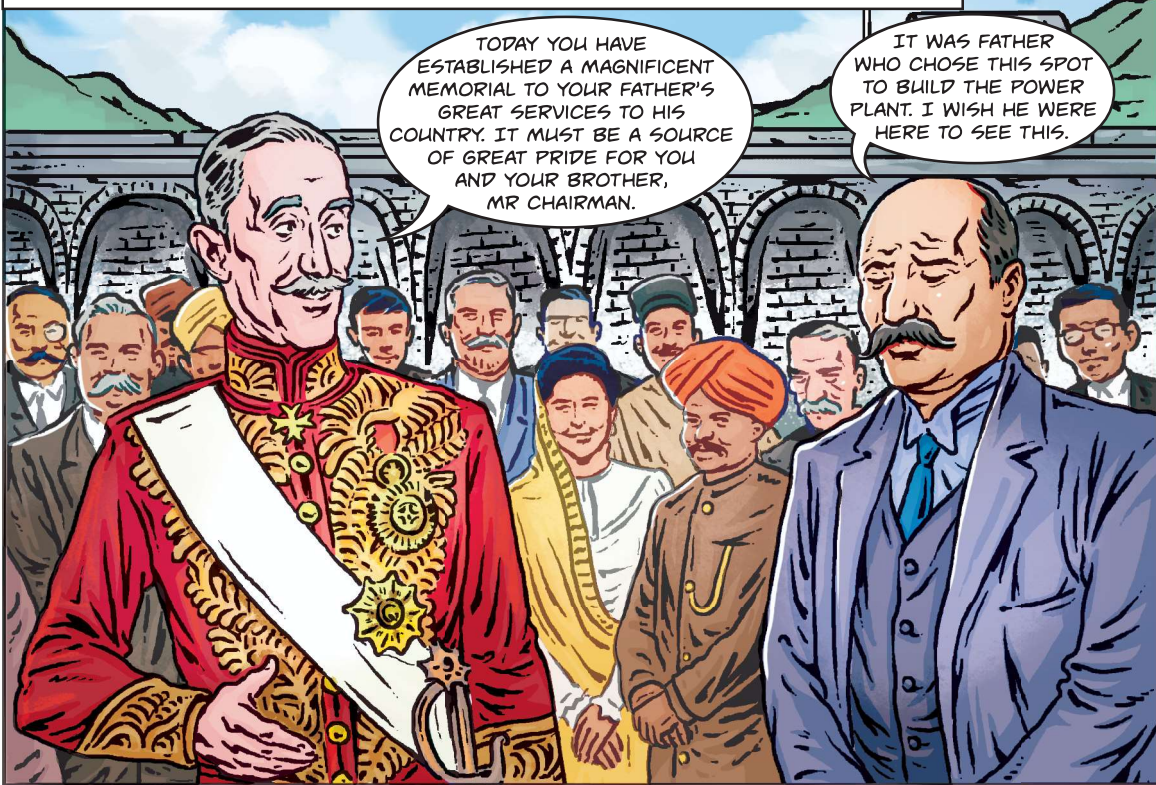

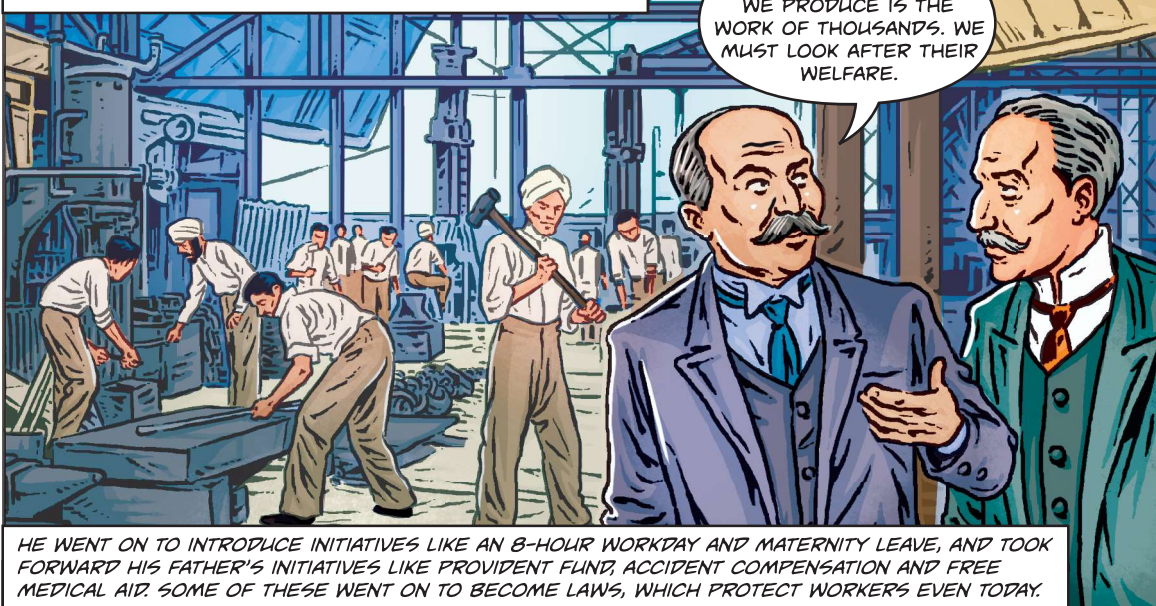
DORAB HAD STARTED WORKING TOWARDS THIS IN 1910, WHEN HE SET UP THE TATA HYDRO-ELECTRIC POWER SUPPLY COMPANY. IN 1915, THE FIRST HYDROELECTRIC POWER GENERATING STATION WAS INAUGURATED BY LORD WILLINGDON, THE GOVERNOR OF BOMBAY.



TODAY YOU HAVE ESTABLISHED A MAGNIFICENT MEMORIAL TO YOUR FATHER'S GREAT SERVICES TO HIS COUNTRY. IT MUST BE A SOURCE OF GREAT PRIDE FOR YOU AND YOUR BROTHER, MR CHAIRMAN.

IT WAS FATHER WHO CHOSE THIS SPOT TO BUILD THE POWER PLANT. I WISH HE WERE HERE TO SEE THIS.

DORAB CONTINUED TO MOVE AHEAD WITH INDEFATIGABLE ENERGY. HE HAD ALREADY SET UP THE INDIAN CEMENT COMPANY IN GUJARAT IN 1912. IN 1919, HE STARTED THE NEW INDIA ASSURANCE COMPANY, WHICH WENT ON TO BECOME THE LARGEST INDIAN INSURANCE COMPANY. BUT THROUGH ALL HIS TRIUMPHS, HE NEVER FORGOT HIS EMPLOYEES.

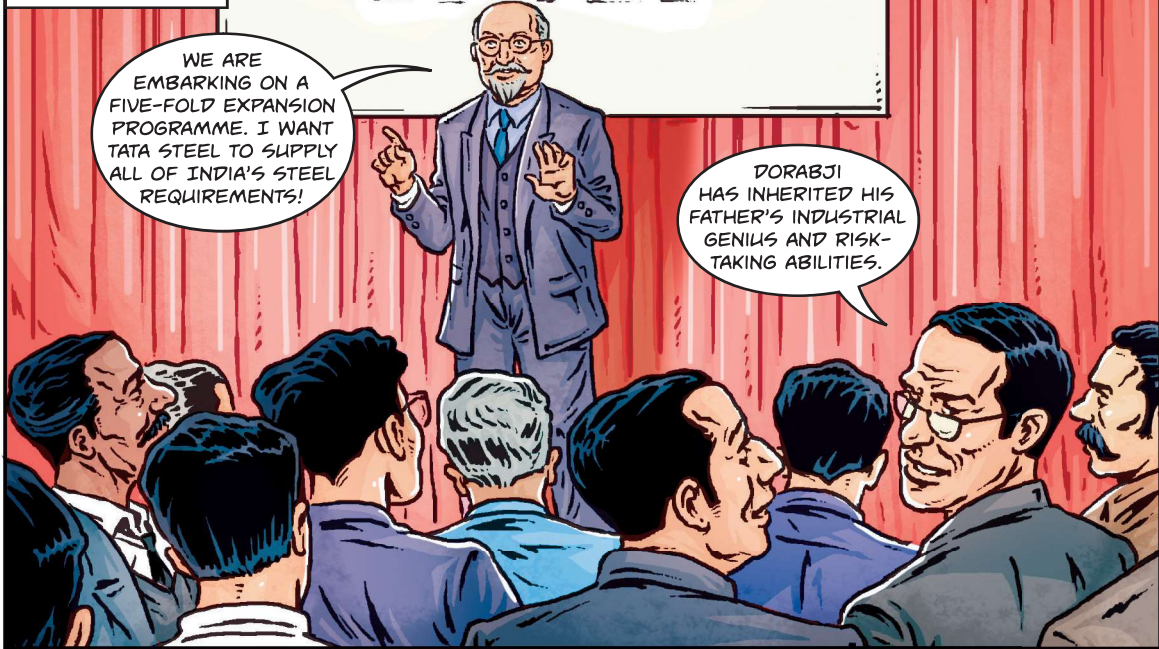


EVERY TON OF STEEL WE PRODUCE IS THE WORK OF THOUSANDS. WE MUST LOOK AFTER THEIR WELFARE.

HE WENT ON TO INTRODUCE INITIATIVES LIKE AN 8-HOUR WORKDAY AND MATERNITY LEAVE, AND TOOK FORWARD HIS FATHER'S INITIATIVES LIKE PROVIDENT FUND, ACCIDENT COMPENSATION AND FREE MEDICAL AID. SOME OF THESE WENT ON TO BECOME LAWS, WHICH PROTECT WORKERS EVEN TODAY.

SPURRED ON BY HIS SUCCESSES, DORAB MADE A BOLD MOVE IN 1924. HE WAS NOW 65 YEARS OLD.

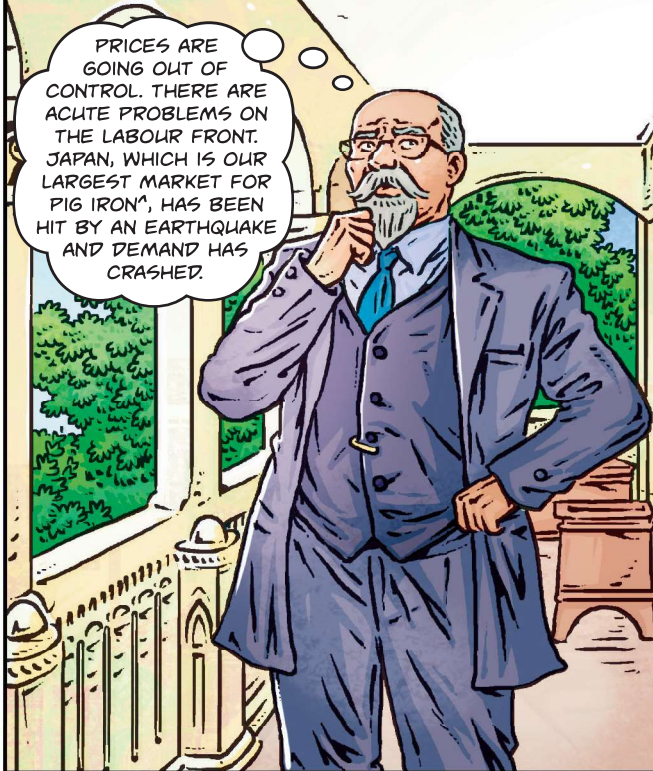

DURING THE 28 YEARS OF HIS TENURE AS CHAIRMAN, THE TATA GROUP STARTED TO TAKE THE SHAPE OF THE CONGLOMERATE THAT IT IS TODAY. UNDER DORAB'S STEWARDSHIP, TATA AND SONS ADDED THREE ELECTRIC POWER COMPANIES, A LARGE EDIBLE OIL AND SOAP COMPANY, TWO CEMENT COMPANIES, ONE OF INDIA'S LEADING INSURANCE COMPANIES, AN AVIATION UNIT, AND AN INTEGRATED STEEL PLANT. 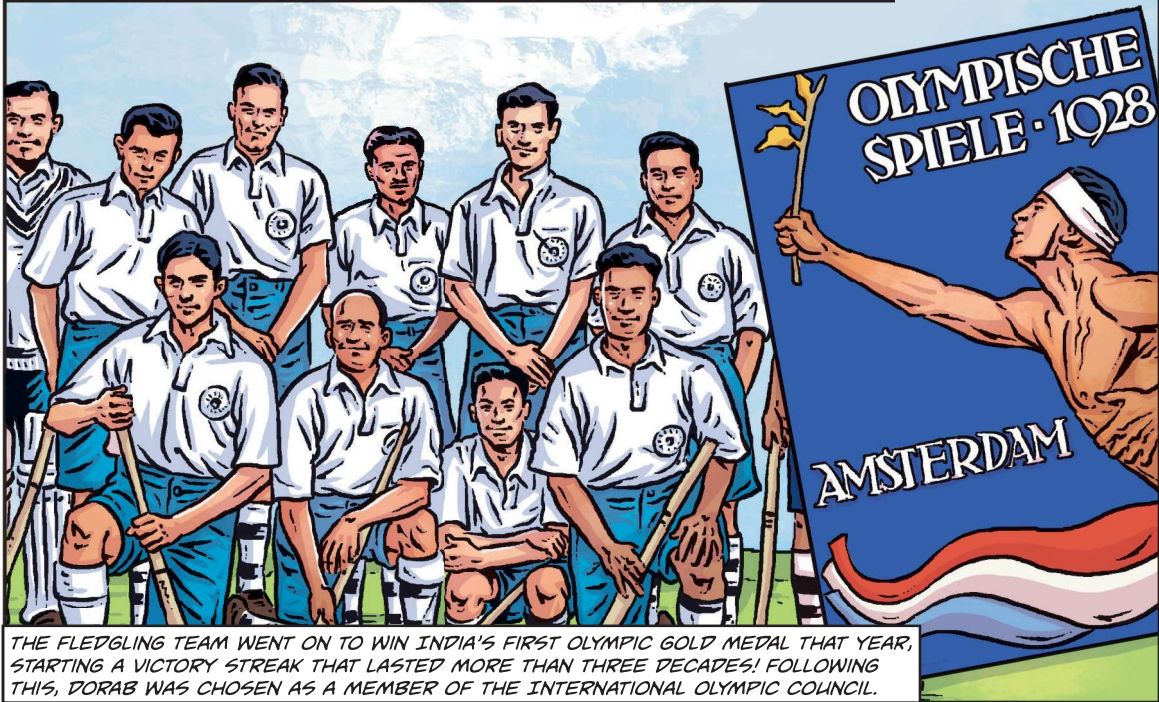


WRESTLER RANDHIR SHINDE'S EVEN MANAGED TO REACH THE SEMI-FINALS.

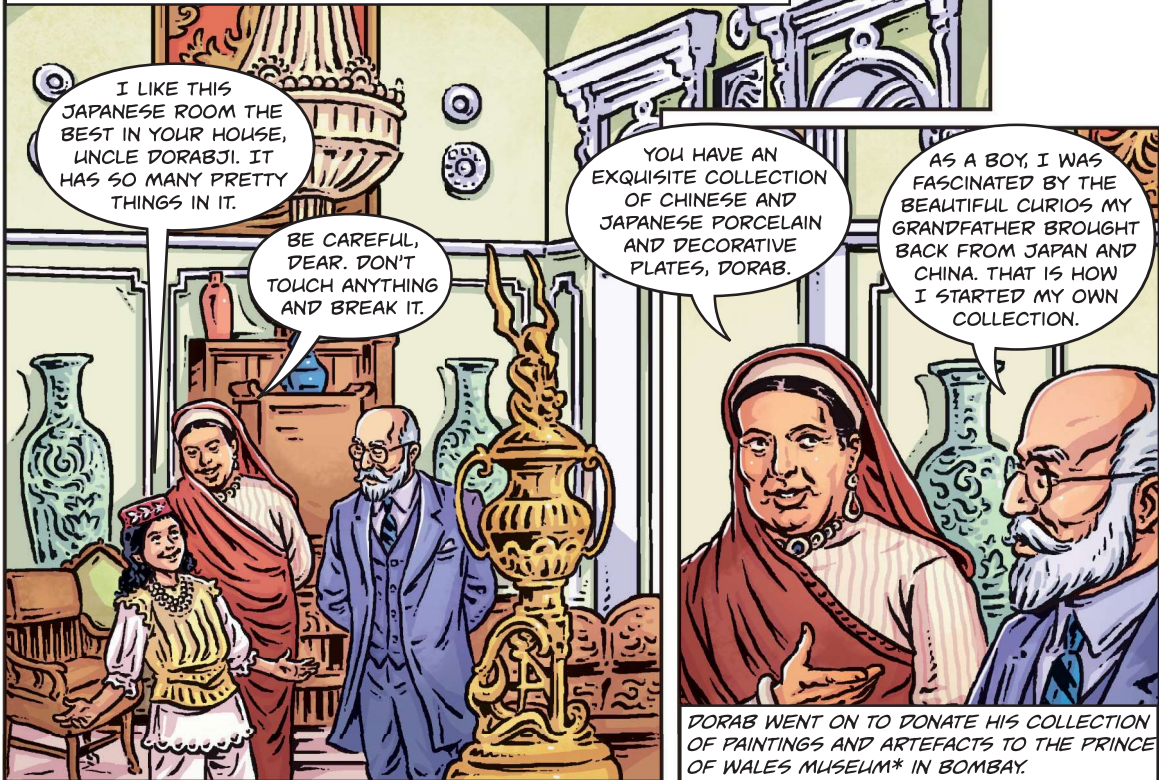
